The Central Committee unanimously approved the merger of the Sikkim State Federation and the Andaman & Nicobar Union Territory Federation with the West Bengal NCBE State Federation, and the merger of the Lakshadweep Union Territory Federation with the Kerala State Federation, in view of the fact that, apart from the State Bank of India, no other banks operate in these regions.

Further, the House decided to strengthen the District Committees in order to enhance the organization. Accordingly, we request the above mentioned State Presidents and General Secretaries to confirm to the undersigned the formation of District Units before November 2025. Each District Committee shall comprise a District Secretary and District Treasurer of the respective district, responsible for coordinating the activities of NCBE.

Each member shall contribute Rs. 10/- per month to the State Federation to ensure the effective functioning of the NCBE State Federations. The NCBE District Units shall organize programs such as Independence Day, May Day, Women's Day, activist camps, and summer camps. State Federations are also required to maintain updated records of the membership of each affiliate functioning in their respective States.

All affiliates are requested to submit (ncbevoice@gmail.com) details of the activities conducted in their respective District and State Federations to the NCBE Headquarters, so that the same may be published in 'NCBE VOICE' and on the 'NCBE WhatsApp Channel'.

Comrades, the strength of our Confederation lies in the unity, discipline, and commitment of each one of us. Let us take forward the decisions of this Central Committee with renewed energy and determination, ensuring vibrant District and State Federations across the country. Together, with collective effort and unwavering solidarity, we shall safeguard the rights of bank employees and build a stronger NCBE for the future.
