## **AMENDED CIRCULAR**

### **CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 29.07.2024 : CHANDIGARH**

The Central Committee Meeting of National Confederation of Bank Employees was convened on the 29<sup>th</sup> July 2024 at Hotel Park View, Sector-24 Chandigarh, under the Chairmanship of R.Balaji, President, who was present on the dais, along with Com. Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish, General Secretary, Com. Arun Bhagoliwal Sr. Vice President, Com. Milind Nadkarni, Sr. Vice President and Vice Presidents Com. K N Anzil, Com. N.Murugesan, Com. Kshitij Pathak, Com. Rajesh Singh, Com. R Sriram, Com. L Chandrashekhar where in the undernoted decisions were taken.

2. Com.Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish, General Secretary commenced the proceedings by reading out the minutes of the previous Central Committee Meeting held on 05<sup>th</sup> February 2023 at Panchkula and the house approved the same with big applause.
3. The General Secretary then apprised the house of the latest developments at the Industry level and successful signing of 12<sup>th</sup> Bipartite Settlement with the IBA. Com.Bandlish further elaborated the highlights of the 12<sup>th</sup> Bipartite Settlement for which the house gave a exuberant applause.
4. Subsequently, the affiliated Unions were reminded of their pending Annual Affiliation Fees and Levy payable to NCBE, the Affiliated Federating Unions responded positively, assured prompt payment of pending fees and Levy amount at the earliest.
5. Thereafter, the Committee unanimously approved the accounts of NCBE for the calendar year 2022, 2023 and Financial Year 2021-22 & 2022-23 and financial statement of expenditure for the period 01.04.2024 to 25.07.2024.

Com.Bandlish advised all the members of Central Committee to form the State Units wherever those have not been formed and asked the State Federation to conduct the meetings as and when it is due to strengthen the State Federation and asked them to give full support to the minority unions working in their State.
7. The Agenda regarding Principal Positions in NCBE (Working or Retired) was discussed at length, with all the Federating Unions presenting their view points. It was decided to give mandate to Com. Bandlish to elect a new General Secretary of NCBE after finalisation of General Secretary position of AISBISF. All the affiliates of NCBE unanimously decided that the General Secretary position of both NCBE and AISBISF should be with the same person adhering to the long-standing practice of the organisation.

As listed in Agenda No. 4, the following members have been Co-opted inanimously


