FRATERNAL SUPPORT TO ONE DAY NATIONWIDE GENERAL STRIKE

We place on record that the National Confederation of Bank Employees extends its fraternal support and solidarity to the one-day nationwide General Strike being observed on 12th February 2026, pursuant to the call given by the organisations, namely AIBEA, AIBOA and BEFI, in coordination with the Central Trade Unions.

2. The strike reflects the rising concern among workers over a series of policy measures implemented by the Government that are viewed as harmful to labour interests in general and to the banking sector in particular. These include ongoing efforts towards the privatisation of Public Sector Banks, disinvestment initiatives, and policies that weaken the developmental and institutional role of the banking system
3. Further, the notification of the four new Labour Codes, replacing the existing labour legislations, has given rise to serious apprehensions among trade unions regarding the dilution of long-established labour rights, including collective bargaining and the effective functioning of trade unions.
4. In this broader context, and in solidarity with the general trade union movement, we are extending our fraternal support to the nationwide strike scheduled on 12th February 2026, along with the related campaign programmes, namely campaign through social media platforms on 08.02.2026, badge wearing on 09.02.2026, and demonstrations at all centres on 11.02.2026 & 12.02.2026.
